

## **DR. BARBARA G. MOOREHEAD, PSY.D**



Barbara G. Moorehead, Psy.D., is a Clinical Psychologist at a correctional complex in Oakdale Louisiana, and in private practice in Alexandria, Louisiana.

She obtained her Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology at The University of the Virgin Islands, her Master of Arts and Doctorate in Clinical Psychology at Argosy University, and her Post-Doctoral Master of Science in Psychopharmacology from Alliant International University.

She completed two pre-doctoral practica at the neuropsychological facility, Rehab Without Walls, and the Federal Correctional Center in Phoenix, Arizona; internship at The Federal Medical Center, Fort Worth, Texas; and her post-doctoral training as a Staff Psychologist at the Federal Correctional Complex in Oakdale, LA.

Her private practice focuses primarily on diagnostic evaluation and treatment of both adults and children, but she maintains a treatment caseload of clients with trauma histories, mental health management difficulties, behavioral issues, and those seeking employee assistance program services.

Dr. Moorehead also conducts contracted evaluations of veterans and others seeking compensation and services. She serves on the National Restrictive Housing Taskforce; and the Chief Psychologist Cadre, mentoring new correctional psychologists in the supervisory role.

She has been the recipient of the Correctional Programs Special Recognition Award.

Dr. Moorehead has served as a Public Health Service clinician, Member of the Board of City Park Players (community theater), and member of Central Louisiana's Red River Chorale.
