Scholarships

The Agnes Morris Educational Scholarship Fund is open to any BPW/LA member over 25 who wants to continue her education through college courses, professional certification courses, technical college, or SBA seminars. Applications are due February 1 of each year. For more information, go to our website and click on *Scholarships*. Several of our Local Organizations also sponsor scholarships.

Young Careerist® Program

The Young Careerist® Program provides training leadership, and professional development skills for working women 21-35 years of age. The program offers unique learning opportunities for personal and professional growth and leadership experiences through participation in workshops on Networking, Mentoring, Interviewing, Preparing Presentations, and Public Speaking; face-to-face and virtual training sessions are available. The Louisiana Young Careerist® winner is selected at the BPW Louisiana State Conference in June of each year, based on panel judging in categories including a speech, personal interview or group interview/presentation, and a biographical sketch with essay questions. Advocacy

Our Legislative Platform includes passage of the Equal Rights Amendment, Economic Equity for Women, and Women's Violence Prevention. BPW Louisiana is a member of the United for Equality Coalition, which supports the 3-State Strategy for elimination of the 1982 deadline for ERA ratification. Our partners in this effort include well-known professional women's organizations including the AAUW, the League of Women's Voters, LA Movement, and YWCA; there are over 50 national organizations in this coalition. We support Economic Equity because Louisiana's women have the largest wage gap of college-educated women over 25 of any state in the nation and Washington DC.

Speakers

At our biannual state meetings (January and June), we provide speakers on women's issues and professional and personal development topics. Recent topics have included "Bulletproofing Your Job," "What Women Want—A Generational Difference in the Workplace," "Emerging Iraqi Democracy," "Osteoporosis Prevention," "Interviewing Do's and Dont's," "Legal Document Every Woman Needs," and "Negotiating Skills—Reaching Win-Win."

BPW Foundation's pilot project, <u>Moving from Red to Green:</u> <u>Working Women in the Green Economy</u> will explore the demand for green jobs for women and determine what programs and services can successfully prepare and link women with the jobs and the companies that will best suit their needs. The result will be moving women from unemployment, or underemployment, to providing them with access to sustainable job options and the skills and support they need to succeed. This project also serves as primary research to investigate how to train, educate and prepare women for the green economy.
